TRAVEL TIPS

How to reach Brussels

- **Easiest and shortest way**
 - Arrive at Brussels National Airport
 - Take a train from Brussels National Airport (level -2) to Brussels North Train station (15 min)
 - Walk to the hotel (10 min)
- **Other option, in some cases cheaper, but longer**
 - Arrive at Charleroi airport
 - Take a shuttle bus (+-17€) from Charleroi airport to Brussels South Train station (1 hour)
 - Take a train or metro from Brussels South Train station to Brussels North Train station (+-5 min)
 - Walk to the hotel (10 min)
